When all the accounts of conversion are examined together, we learn that everyone did exactly the same thing to be saved. Water baptism is essential, but by itself it does not save. One must first Hear the word

(John 6:46-47; Rom. 10:17). One must Believe that Jesus is the Son of God (John 8:24; Heb. 11:6). One must Repent of their sins (Luke 13:3,5; Acts 17:30). One must Confess faith that Jesus is the Son of God (Matt. 10:32-33; Acts 8:37; Rom. 10:9-10). One must be Baptized (Acts 2:38). Water Baptism is the step that takes one who is "out" of Christ and puts him/her "into" Christ (Rom. 6:3; Gal. 3:27). Each one heard, believed, repented, confessed and were baptized in water for the forgiveness of their sins. In water baptism, one contacts the blood of Christ that washes sins away (Rev. 1:5; Eph. 1:7; 1 Peter 3:21). Jesus said, "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved" (Mark 16:16). He also said, "Why call ye me Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say" (Luke 6:46)? Will you fight against Christ and his inspired word or will you humbly and sincerely submit in full obedience to his Word? Don't go to judgment fighting against the Lord. Why not obey the Gospel today and you will be added to, and be a member of, the church of Christ (Acts 2:41,47)? You then must live Faithful to the Lord the rest of your life (1 Cor. 15:58; Rev. 2:10; James 1:12-16).
